In 1948, three Australian Infantry Battalions were designated as the first Infantry Battalions of the Australian Regiment, these were the 1st, 2nd and 3rd Battalions, Australian Regiment and in 1949 granted the prefix 'Royal' thus becoming the Royal Australian Regiment.

Today, over 65,000 men have served or are still serving in the Royal Australian Regiment in any of the eight Infantry Battalions throughout Australia.
